Serving

A demonstration of serving whilst worshipping

Altar in place with screen behind and marked centre and North aisle, with box for Gospel procession and crosses for lights either side of altar. Chairs for servers to sit on south side. Covered Monstrance and Humeral Veil on table on North Side. Two candles lit on altar, and box for monstrance (maybe flowers if I have any left) - further 6 candles to be lit during the worship.

Initial brief and singing practice – Gospel acclamation, The light of Christ: Thanks be to God, follow the instructions on the screen, always turn to face the procession

When the servers are not in procession they sit on the South side on chairs.

Notices

1st Procession

Pascal Candle – No lights on

Priest **Deacon** **Boat**
 with **Thrifer**
 Gospel

Deacon sings; The light of Christ: **Thanks be to God**

Back of Hall
Gospel box
Front of Hall

Place on stand (centre lights on)

Procession moves up north aisle to back of hall

2nd Procession

As if the start of a Mass (cense altar):
Or your preferred order (everywhere has a difference of opinion!!)

Devotion of the Blessed Sacrament



Altar

All kneeling:

**Acolyte Cross Deacon Priest Thrifer Boat Acolyte
Without
Cross**

Once all in place deacon will place the Monstrance on the Altar

Lord's Prayer (Pop Goes the Weasel)

Deacon will dress priest with Humeral Veil

Blessing (bells and incense)

Deacon remove monstrance

Great Amen (Kum By Yah)

Final Procession

Process out to door on south side

Priest **Deacon** **Acolyte** **Boat**
 Cross **Thrifer**
